**Students: SAFETY TOWN NEEDS YOU!**

This summer, an exciting and innovative child safety program titled "Safety Town" will once again be offered to kindergarten age children in Cherokee County. Safety Town is a "pint-sized" town which teaches and reinforces safety awareness and prevention procedures to youngsters through a variety of safety activities in the classroom and outdoors in a miniature town. They will practice safety lessons involving strangers, fire, playground, school buses, water, poisons, and much more. Children will experience "hands on" pedestrian and vehicle safety lessons as they ride a child size vehicle through a miniature town which includes child size safety signs.

***Teenage Instructor Volunteers*** are needed to assist the teacher, police officers, firemen, and the children at Safety Town. We invite you to become involved in this wonderful program. At the completion of Safety Town, we will send a letter to your guidance counselor and principal which will verify this community service.

If you choose to volunteer you will be required to attend a mandatory ***Teenage Instructor Volunteer*** training session which will be held on Tuesday, May 26 at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Woodstock from 6 - 9 pm.

You can volunteer for one or all of four sessions offered: **Session #1 - June 8 - 12; Session #2 June 15 - 19; Session #3 June 22 - 26 and June 29 - July 2<sup>nd</sup> (4 days)** at Bascomb Elementary School on Wyngate Parkway in Woodstock. The program runs daily from 9 am to Noon and you will be expected to attend all days of your session from 8:45 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. We reserve the right to place students in sessions where they are most needed, which may or may not be all sessions applied for.

- **Volunteers will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Space is limited.**
- **You can volunteer for multiple sessions.**
- **Volunteers must be at least 12 years of age.**
- **Veteran volunteers MUST complete the volunteer form.**
- **ALL Volunteers must attend the training meeting on May 26<sup>th</sup> (See above.)**
